

BYLAW CHANGES

31 Elections

33 1. Beginning with the calendar year 1965, and yearly thereafter, the members of each

34 District shall hold their annual district nominations at their regular meeting either in the

35 month of April or May. They shall nominate the District Board of Directors, a State

36 Director Alternate, and in those Districts where the State Director's term will expire in

37 that year, a State Director. A member need not be present to be nominated.

38

39 2. Thereafter, each member in the District who is qualified to vote shall be notified in

40 writing of the nominees. The member will vote by ballot which will be returned to the

41 PCA office within 10 days.

42

43 3. Each qualified member of the District shall be entitled to cast one (1) vote for each

44 office to be filled.

45

The nominees receiving the highest number of votes shall

1 be deemed elected. The term

2 of State Director shall be three (3) years beginning at the close of the next annual meeting

3 of the members of the Association.

4 Section 2. Annual Dues. The full annual dues for a member, effective January 1,
1993,

5 and thereafter, shall be Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), except that members who
have

6 been practicing in Pennsylvania for less than four (4) years shall have
graduated dues as

7 follows:

9 First Year in Practice \$

72.00 (SeventyTwo

Dollars)

11 Second Year in Practice – 25% of full annual dues

13 Third Year in Practice – 50% of full annual dues

15 Fourth year and thereafter, full annual dues of \$600.00 (Six Hundred Dollars).

Section 2: Annual Dues: The full dues for a member, effective
January 1, 2011, and thereafter, shall be Six Hundred Sixty
Dollars(\$660.00). Membership dues may be reevaluated yearly by the
Board of Directors. At that time, the Board may raise dues with a majority
vote of the Board of Directors, not to exceed 10% of the present dues.

3. Delete section (b)(ii) below:

(b)(ii). At the 1997 Annual Meeting of the Members of the Pennsylvania Chiropractic
39 Association, the Pennsylvania Chiropractic Association's Board of Directors shall
consist

40 of twentysix

(26) members. Seventeen (17) shall be from the new redistricting plan as

41 provided for in these bylaws. The President, Chairman of the Board, and Past
President
42 positions shall be as provided for in these bylaws. The final six (6) shall be
elected by
43 the Pennsylvania Chiropractic Association membership at the time they elect the
44 Pennsylvania Chiropractic Association President. The nominations for these six
(6)
45 positions shall be as follows: the nine (9) members of the initial Pennsylvania
46 Chiropractic Association Board that came from the PCS shall nominate at
least four (4)
previous PCS members, and the nine (9) members of 1
the initial Pennsylvania
2 Chiropractic Association Board that came from the PCF shall nominate at least
four (4)
3 previous PCF members. These nominations will be sent to the Pennsylvania
Chiropractic
4 Association membership to elect three (3) individuals from each list of candidates.
Those
5 six (6) shall be interim Directors for a period of two (2) years. The first year (from
the
6 1997 Annual Meeting of the members to the 1998 Annual Meeting) they shall have
a
7 vote on the Board. The second year (from the 1998 Annual Meeting of the
members to
8 the 1999 annual Meeting) they shall act as advisors and shall not have a vote on
the
9 Pennsylvania Chiropractic Association Board. The transition process shall be
complete
10 at the 1999 Annual Meeting of the Members of the Pennsylvania Chiropractic
11 Association, at which time the Board of Directors shall consist of twenty (20)
members.

Pennsylvania Chiropractic Association's Board of Directors shall consist of President/Chairman of the Board, 1st VP, 2nd VP, Secretary, Treasurer, 15 District Directors, 1 Western and 1 Eastern Director at Large. At this time, the Board shall consist of 22 members.
